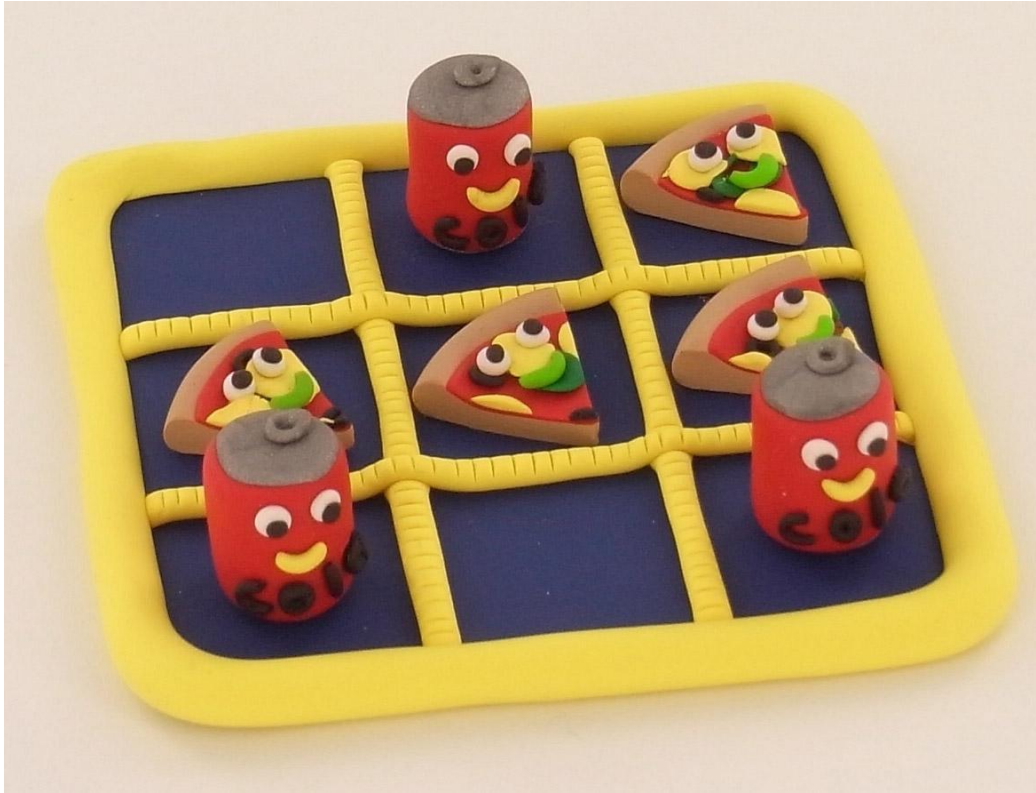

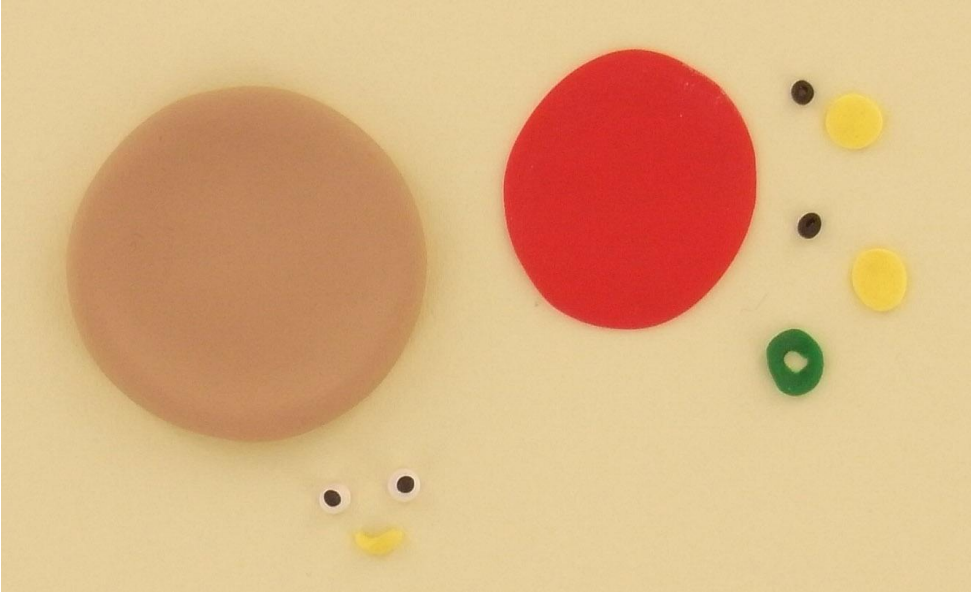
GETTING STARTED

Preheat oven to 275 °F. Test temperature with oven thermometer for perfectly cured clay. Condition all clay by kneading until it's soft and smooth, about 2 minutes.

STEP 1

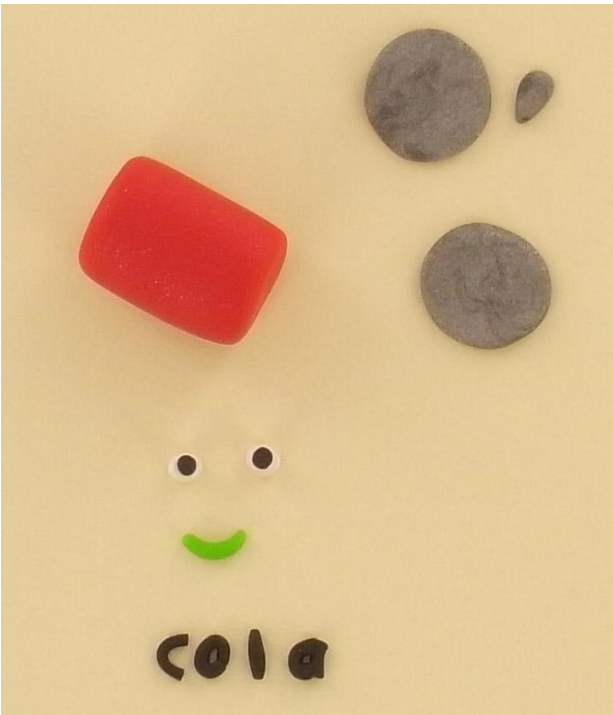
Roll 1/8" thick Blue clay sheet and place on baking surface. Cut 3" x 3" square. Roll four 1/8" thick x 3" long Lemonade snakes. Place the snakes on square and press lines with knife tool. Roll 1/4" thick x 12" long Lemonade log. Press around edge of square and smooth seam.

STEP 2



Make 3/4" Tan ball and flatten into 1-1/2" circle, leaving thicker edge to make pizza crust. Make 1/2" Red Hot Red ball and flatten; place on pizza crust for sauce. Press on 1/4" Lemonade flattened balls for cheese. Press on small Emerald logs for green peppers. Press on small Black dots for black olives. Use knife tool to cut pizza into 6 pieces. Make 12 small White balls and press on tiny Black balls for eyes. Press two eyes on each pizza slice. Make 6 small curved Granny Smith logs and press on pizza slices to make smiles.

STEP 3



Make 1/2" thick x 6" long Red Hot Red log. Cut six 3/4" long sections to make cola cans. Make twelve 1/4" Pewter balls and flatten; place on can tops and bottoms. Make six tiny Pewter teardrops and press on can

tops to make pop tops. Make 12 small White balls and press on tiny Black balls for eyes. Press two eyes on each can. Make 6 small curved Lemonade logs and press on cans to make smiles. Roll very thin, long Black log and cut into small pieces to spell out "cola" on each can.

STEP 4

Bake according to directions above and allow to cool completely.
