1  $\frac{1}{2}$  hours plus drying time

### **Main Supplies:**

Pepperell® Silkie™ necklace

Pepperell® Silkie™ O beads

Elmer's® Craft Bond™ Tacky Glue

Elmer's® School Glue Gel

Pepperell® Lanyard hooks - colored





### Basic Supplies:

Freezer paper

Cardboard

Scissors

Craft glitter - in desired colors

Hole Punch -  $\frac{1}{4}$ ",  $\frac{1}{8}$ "

Clear tape

Paper towel

### Instructions:

1. Cover cardboard with sheet of freezer paper, shiny side out taping to back.
2. Cut out heart pattern. Place on freezer paper then trace around with felt pen, tracing desired number and leaving about 2" between, then draw on five 2" squares.
3. Fill in one design with Blue Gel glue applying an even layer. Immediately sprinkle glitter over wet glue making sure all glue is covered. Repeat step with remaining designs using a different color for each design.
4. Let dry - this may take overnight depending on humidity. The glue will peel from paper when dry. Shake off excess glitter onto paper towel.
5. Punch a small hole where shown on hearts then insert lanyard hook into hole. Cut a smaller heart from glitter squares then glue in place. A hole punch can be used to create dots of glitter then glued into place. Let dry.
6. String on Silkie adding pony beads as shown.
