Main Supplies:

Pepperell® Silkie™ necklace Pepperell® Silkie™ O beads Elmer's® Craft Bond™ Tacky Glue Elmer's® School Glue Gel Pepperell® Lanyard hooks - colored







Basic Supplies:

Freezer paper Cardboard Scissors Craft glitter - in desired colors Hole Punch - $\frac{1}{4}$ ", 1/8" Clear tape Paper towel

Instructions:

- 1. Cover cardboard with sheet of freezer paper, shiny side out taping to back.
- 2. Cut out heart pattern. Place on freezer paper then trace around with felt pen, tracing desired number and leaving about 2" between, then draw on five 2" squares.
- 3. Fill in one design with Blue Gel glue applying an even layer. Immediately sprinkle glitter over wet glue making sure all glue in covered. Repeat step with remaining designs using a different color for each design.
- 4. Let dry this may take overnight depending on humidity. The glue will peel from paper when dry. Shake off excess glitter onto paper towel.
- 5. Punch a small hole where shown on hearts then insert lanyard hook into hole. Cut a smaller heart from glitter squares then glue in place. A hole punch can be used to create dots of glitter then glued into place. Let dry.
- 6. String on Silkie adding pony beads as shown.



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
