Basic Materials:

Acrylic paint in desired colors (bright purple, teal, green)

Pipe cleaner assortment

Acrylic bead assortment

2.5" twig pieces

Plastic knife

Paint brush

Instructions:

Cut a small flat spot on the egg and ball with a plastic knife (this is just to keep them from rolling away). Push a twig into the top.

Mix the paper mâché according to the manufacturer's instructions and spread over the Styrofoam ball. Keep your fingers wet when working with the clay. You can make ridges in the pumpkin with your fingers. Set the pumpkin aside to dry.

Paint the pumpkin and stem with desired colors.

Add dots, stripes, and dashes with the glitter gel pens and paint pens. You can even brush the glitter gel out with a paint brush to create an all over sparkle effect.

Wrap a pipe cleaner around the stem and string two or three beads on each side. Finish by twirling the ends of the pipe cleaner around a pencil to make them curl.
