Yellow Bird

Main Materials:

FloraCraft® Styrofoam™ Brand Foam egg

Elmer's® School Glue

Elmer's® Painters® Markers

Pepperell® wooden triangle for beak

Pepperell® wood shaped feet



Basic Materials:

Pipe cleaners
Feathers
Yellow tissue paper
Wiggle eyes
Large craft stick
Acrylic paint
Paint brush
Toothpick
Bowl of water
Plastic knife
Scissors

Steps:

1. Cut the bottom of the Styrofoam egg to create a flat surface. Mix 50% glue and 50% water in a bowl. Use the mixture to glue pieces of tissue paper to the egg and let dry.
2. Paint large craft stick and let dry.
3. Twist 2 pipe cleaners together and twist around the two ends of the craft stick.
4. Glue feet to the craft stick.
5. Decorate egg with feathers, wiggle eyes and beak.
6. Glue finished bird onto craft stick.

Snail

Materials:

FloraCraft® Styrofoam™ Brand Foam ball
Elmer's® School Glue
Pony beads
Elmer's® Foam Board
Google eyes
Pipe cleaner
Paint

Steps:

1. Cut bottom of Styrofoam ball to create a flat surface. Paint the ball by rolling it in paint and let dry.
2. Use pony beads to create spiral like design.
3. Cut head and tail out of foam board, paint and let dry.
4. Push foam board into place and decorate to create a face.
5. Add pipe cleaners to top of face for antenna.
