## Main Supplies:

Recycled sweater sleeves- colors of choice
Felt in colors of choice
Pepperell® Rexlace™ Plastic Lacing in color of your choice
Blumenthal Lansing® buttons
Elmer's® Painters® Markers

Project Popperz® Reusable Plastic Stencils
Elmer's® 3D™ Washable Glitter Paint Pens









## Basic Supplies:

10mm acrylic rhinestones Scissors Thread

#### Instructions:

- 1. Use scissors to cut sweater sleeve at bottom of fit or in position so that cut sleeve fits around a cup snuggly.
- 2. Use fabric marker and patterns provided to trace flower shapes onto two colors of coordinating or contrasting felt. Cut out shapes with scissors.
- 3. Use glue to layer flower shapes together, smaller on top and glue together.
- 4. Glue rhinestones to outer or inner petals of layered flowers. Glue flowers to sweater sleeve.
- 5. Cut 12" of plastic lace with scissors and double over two to three times. Cut a 3" piece of lace and use to tie together pieces as for a bow. Glue lace to flower centers, allow to dry while laying flat. Fit sleeve around cup.
