





Basic Supplies:


Scissors
Pencil
Craft knife
Cutting mat
Ruler

Instructions:

1. Cut out all patterns from pattern sheet. Trace three triangles onto foam core sheet. Carefully cut out using craft knife over cutting mat.



2. Trace patterns onto colored paper following color and number indicated on pattern.
3. Trace triangle on cardstock then cut out cutting about 1/8" outside pencil line creating a slightly larger triangle.

4. Place cardstock triangle, right side down on work surface. Apply a coat of *Glue Stick* to one side of foam core triangle. Press triangle onto cardstock lining up with pencil lines on paper. Flip over and press to secure. Repeat with remaining triangle using colors shown.
5. Use *Glue Stick* to adhere paper pieces to triangle referring to photo for reference.
6. Use *Craft Bond Glue* to glue eyes in place.
7. To create whiskers, twist three chenille stems together at center. Swirl ends as shown, then glue between cheeks. Glue pom pom nose over center of whiskers holding in place for a few seconds to secure. Let dry.
8. Lay ribbon on work surface. Center chick on ribbon then place rabbits about 5" apart on either side. Apply *Craft Bond Tacky Glue* to back of triangle about $\frac{1}{2}$ " down from top then press onto ribbon. Repeat with remaining designs.
9. Tear fabric into 1" or so strips then pull excess threads from sides. Tie a bow from fabric, trim ends in "V" then glue to bottom of each triangle referring to photo.
10. Knot strips around ribbon and trim ends.

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
